
With reference to your online application no 11720/2017 and subsequent correspondence with the school / inspection in this regard, I convey the grant for issuance of Certificate of Recognition to the DU PUBLIC SCHOOL (U-DISE CODE-21130124906), AT/ PO-SUNGUDA, BLOCK/ULB-BADACHANA, DIST-JAJPUR for Class-I to Class-VIII for a period of five years w e f dtd 01.04.2017 to dtd.31.03.2022

The above sanction is subject to fulfilment of following conditions -

- 1 The grant for recognition is not extendable and does not in any way imply any obligation to recognize / affiliate beyond class VIII
- 2 The School shall abide by the provisions of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 and the Odisha Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules 2010
- 3 The School shall admit in class I, to the extent of 25% of the strength of that class, children belonging to weaker section and disadvantaged group in the neighbourhood and provide free and compulsory elementary education till its completion. Provided, further that in case of pre primary classes also, this norm shall be followed
- 4 For the children referred to in paragraph 3 the School shall be reimbursed as per Section 12(2) of the Act. To receive such reimbursements school shall provide a separate bank account
- 5 The School shall not collect any capitation fee and subject the child of his or her parents or guardians to any screening procedure
- 6 The School shall not deny admission to any child for lack of age proof. If such admission is sought subsequent to the extended period prescribed for admission on the ground of religion, caste or race, place of birth or any of them
- 7 The School shall ensure
 - (i) No child admitted shall be held back in any class or expelled from school till the completion of elementary education in a school
 - (ii) No child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment
 - (iii) No child is required to pass any board examination till the completion of elementary education
 - (iv) Every child completing elementary education shall be awarded a certificate as laid down under Rule 22
 - (v) Inclusion of Students with disabilities / special needs as per provision of the Act
 - (vi) The teachers are recruited with minimum qualifications as laid under Section 23(1) of the Act
 - (vii) The teacher performs its duties specified under Section 24(1) of the Act and
 - (viii) The teachers shall not engage themselves for private teaching activities


- 8 The School shall follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum laid down by the authority
- 9 The School shall enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the Section 19 of the Act
- 10 The School shall maintain the standards and norms of the school as specified in Section 19 of the Act. The facilities reported at the time of last inspection are as given under
 - Area of school campus – A 2 00 dec
 - Total built-up area - A 0 28 dec (Approx).
 - Area of play ground - Available
 - No of Class rooms - A 0 13 dec
 - Room for Headmaster-cum-office-cum-storeroom – Available
 - Separate toilet for boys and girls – Boys toilet-08, Girls toilet-04
 - Drinking Water facility - Pipe water with Aquaguard.
 - Kitchen for cooking Mid Day Meal - Available
 - Barrier free access – Ramps is available in the school.
 - Availability of Teaching Learning Material / Play Sport Equipments / Library - Available
11. No unrecognized classes shall run within the premises of the school or outside in the same name of school.
12. The School buildings or other structures or the grounds are used only for the purposes of education and skill development.
13. The School is run by a society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860(21 of 1860), or a public trust constituted under any law for the time being in force;
14. The School is not run for profit to any individual, group or association of individuals or any other persons.
15. The accounts should be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper accounts statements should be prepared as per rules. A copy of each of the Statements of Accounts should be sent to the District Education Officer, Jajpur every year.
16. The recognition Code Number allotted to your schools is JPR0109 This may please be noted and quoted for any correspondence with this office.
17. The School furnishes such reports and information as may be required by the Director, Elementary Education / District Education Officer / Block Education Officer as the case may be from time to time and complies with such instructions of the State Government / Local Authority as may be issued to secure the continued fulfilment of the condition of recognition or the removal of deficiencies in working of the schools
18. Renewal of Registration of Society if any, be ensured.

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Pursuant to the decision of the High Power Committee in its meeting dated 21.9.2016 and Government Letter No. 19943/SME dtd.01.10.16 and as per the guidelines issued by the Government in the Department of School & Mass Education, Odisha, Bhubaneswar and Resolution No. 30720/SME dtd.23.9.96 read with G.O No. 29519/SME dtd.26.9.98 and Objection Certificate (NOC) is hereby granted in favour of DU Public School, G. Indrapada Chhak, Jajpur to open an un-aided High School which is to be affiliated to CBSE subject to the following terms and conditions.

1. The No Objection Certificate now issued shall be subject to the terms and conditions as prescribed in G.O No. 30720/SME dtd. 23.9.96 and No.29519/SME dtd.26.9.1998 read with G.O No 10011/SME dtd 11.6.2004.
2. The school shall be open for inspection by the Inspection Committee.
3. No Financial Assistance and Grant-in-Aid (both recurring & non-recurring) will be claimed by the institution from the Government at any point of time for meeting the salary cost and its component towards teaching and non-teaching staff appointed by the Managing Committee for meeting any other expenses for managing the school.
4. The High Power Committee shall be competent to review the NOC granted to the Institution concerned and shall be competent to withdraw the same if any of the terms and conditions contained in G.O No.30720/SME dtd.23.9.96 and No.29519/SME dtd.26.9.98 read with G.O No 10011/SME dtd 11.6.2004 are violated at any time.
5. The Managing Committee shall be constituted in accordance with the Sec. 7 of the Orissa Education Act-1969.
6. The Managing Committee of the school will not shift the present location of the school without prior approval of Director, Secondary Education, Odisha.
7. The Managing Committee shall ensure the continuity of all eligibility criteria for Grant of NOC. If any deterioration from present status of the school is detected at any point of time then the NOC shall be withdrawn.
8. The school authority shall apply in the prescribed form for NOC on or before 15 January of the year with the prescribed fee.
9. If at any point of time it is found that information submitted by the school is not in conformity with the field position, appropriate legal action against the school authority will be initiated besides withdrawal of NOC.
10. The school is stipulated to fulfil the deficiencies (given below) within a period of 3 months.

- i. Roll strength to be increased.
- ii. Trained teachers should be appointed.

The organisation/individual which has applied for NOC will submit an affidavit within a period of one month to the effect that it has fulfilled the above requirements, failing which the NOC will be withdrawn.
